
Landscape: Why?

“As a reflection of European identity and diversity, the landscape is our living natural and cultural heritage, be it ordinary or outstanding, urban or rural, on land or in water.”







Natural capital drives EU regional growth

Investing in nature pays off: natural capital plays a significant role in driving regional economic growth in the EU, both as a direct effect and via spillovers from one region to adjacent ones.

“A 10 % increase in the average annual value of natural capital [...] would result in a €71.4 billion increase (0.7% of €10,195 billion) in gross value added in the EU regions”








Distribuzione spaziale delle aree di generazione del deflusso (Run-off)






Distribuzione spaziale delle aree di generazione del deflusso in corrispondenza della precipitazione media annuale.




